- Why** Proverbs 31:28

- Time** Approximately 3-5 minutes long; This script is 1½ pages long.

*Two women are on stage facing the audience. Melinda is holding cards.*

**Carrie:** Hello. I'm Carrie.

**Melinda:** And I'm Melinda. Carrie and I have decided it'd be a good idea to prepare a statement for our families who are out there searching for that perfect, elusive Mother's Day gift. Now, Carrie and I differ somewhat on ideas for this gift... but Carrie won the coin toss. So I will be her interpreter. Carrie?

*Melinda holds up cards throughout Carrie's monologue.*

**Carrie:** Thank you, Melinda. To our loved ones- our husbands, our children, and Ms. Bonita down at the corner coffee shop that makes those little chocolate chip muffins that are so good...

**Melinda:** *(She snaps Carrie back to focus)* Carrie.

**Carrie:** Right, sorry. We know you work hard all day long at your jobs and at school, so we want to take a moment to say that on this Mother's Day all we need is your love, *(Melinda flips to the card with a big question mark)* your time and your affection. There's no need for material gifts *(flip to card that says "Yeah there is!)* such as flowers, or jewelry, or gift cards. We feel your appreciation in your hugs, *(flip to card "Kids are sticky)* your smiles, that little sparkle in your eye *(flip to card "that usually means trouble)*. Plus, the homemade cards and the clay handprints *(flip to card "I have handprints all over my house")*.

All those special moments I will cherish- the first words, the first time you walked, all those nights I stayed up with you when you were sick *(flip to card "You threw up all over my bunny slippers")*. I love taking care of you. *(Flip to card "I loved those bunny slippers")*
