- Wear (Props)** No props necessary
Angel should be dressed in older clothes to look like he/she could be homeless, but don't go over the top.
- Why** Hebrews 13:2
- How** This is mostly a conversation between Angel and God. Give God a conversational voice and not a huge booming voice and be careful not to make Angel whiny. Angel could either be male or female.
- Time** Approximately 3-4 minutes

Angel is finished eating dinner with a kind family. He/she addresses the Host.

Angel: Thank you again so much for this. I'll...never forget it.

Host: No problem, Angel. It was our pleasure. And remember, if you need a place for Christmas, you know where we are. And remember, 1 Timothy 4:4.

Angel: Yep, 1 Timothy 4:4.

Host walks offstage. Angel does not look well.

Angel: How can 8 people eat 12 turkeys? I'm... *(appears sick to his stomach)*
I'm gonna...

God: *(Voice from offstage)* Angel.

Angel: *(Perks up)* Yes Lord.

God: You're not going to be sick. Stand up straight.

Angel: Yes, Lord.

God: Angel, please tell me what First Timothy 4:4 says.

Angel: "For every creation of God is good and no food is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving." Tell me Lord, did you need a 2nd Timothy because the first didn't survive Thanksgiving?

God: You know it was the same Timothy.

Angel: I know, but what I don't know is why I ate that third ice cream sundae.

God: The food aside, tell me about the people that entertained you tonight.

Angel: Okay, well, there was Fred, the husband, he was a really nice guy. He's the one that invited me to Thanksgiving.

God: And where did he meet you?

Angel: At the gas station. Don't these people know it's not safe to invite people home that you meet at a gas station?

God: We'll get to that. Go on.
