- What** Six-year-old Timmy learns about the Holy Spirit. **Themes:** Holy Spirit, Kids, Teaching Moments, Father, Son, Trinity
- Who** Timmy
Dad
- When** Present Day
- Wear (Props)** White sheet with two holes (used as a ghost costume)
- Why** Acts 1:8, Matthew 28:19, Ephesians 4:4-6
- How** You may want to use a child that is a little bit older than the script calls for to play Timmy to make rehearsing and learning lines a bit easier.
- Time** Approximately 2-3 minutes

Timmy enters wearing a sheet with two holes cut out for eyes. He tries to sneak up on his Dad.

Timmy: BOO!

Dad: Oh, hey...Timmy?

Timmy: I'm not Timmy, I'm the Holy Spirit, WOOOOOOO!

Dad: It's summer son. Why are you dressed for Halloween?

Timmy: Our Sunday school teacher said that it's good to catch the Holy Spirit so...CATCH ME! *(Starts running off)*

Dad: Come back here.

Timmy: *(Whining)* But Daaaad, you're supposed to catch the Holy Spirit.

Dad: That's not what she meant by catching the Holy Spirit, Son.

Timmy: Oh. Can I ask you a question Dad?

Dad: Sure.

Timmy: Does the Holy Spirit say "BOO"?

Dad: I don't think so, no.

Timmy: Oh. Does it say "BLESS"?

Dad: All the time.

Timmy: That's not as scary as "boo" though.

Dad: Well, it's not supposed to be scary.

Timmy: Then what's it supposed to be?

Dad: Inspiring. He's not supposed to scare you away, He's supposed to draw you closer to God. He's that thing that speaks directly to your soul, letting you know what you should be doing to better serve God.
