## “Daddy Daughter Date #1”

- What** A dad and his young daughter go on their very first “date” and realizes that this is the perfect opportunity to say what she needs to hear...how much he loves her. Themes: Father’s Day, dad, child, parenting, daughter, expressing love
- Who** Daddy  
Daughter- around 5-7 yrs. old  
Waitress- 25 yrs. old
- When** Father’s Day
- Wear (Props)** Restaurant setting:  
Table  
Chairs  
Table set-up- plates, cups, silverware, etc.  
Chocolate chip pancakes  
Almost empty syrup bottle  
Full syrup bottle  
Waitress can be wearing an apron with pad and pen
- Why** Proverbs 22:6; 1 Corinthians 13
- How** Give yourself plenty of time to work with the child in your skit. The more she feels comfortable onstage, the smoother things will go. There are, however, those unforeseen things that will happen that you as the actor will have to be prepared for. Make sure you train the child to be prepared for those things too. In fact, run through the skit and cause things to happen on purpose so that the child can practice moving on even though the syrup bottle makes a funny noise, etc. Teach the child to really listen to what you’re saying. If she doesn’t, it will show and the audience will have a hard time focusing on your words as well.
- Time** Approximately 4-6 minutes; This script is 2 pages long.

*Father and daughter enter, hand in hand.*

**Dad:** Okay, honey, let's go back to our table. Daddy will never get used to taking you to the bathroom in a public place. Awkward! *(They sit down at the table)* Alright! Are you hungry? *(She nods her head "yes")* Me too!

**Waitress:** Okay, who had the chocolate chip pancakes?

**Dad:** *(Points to his daughter)* Right here.

**Waitress:** Then these have to be yours. *(She hands him another plate of pancakes)* If you need anything I'll just be right over here.

*The Waitress walks over to a counter and does "work" while the scene is going on; she can do busy work like work on receipts or fold napkins, etc. She has to overhear the conversation with the dad and daughter.*

**Dad:** You want me to cut those up for you? *(She nods her head "yes")* Okay. Well, me and your mom were talking...mostly your mom was talking...and I was listening. She was saying that you're growing up so fast which I totally agree and that we need to spend some more time together. So I was thinking that we'd do some Daddy/Daughter dates together. And I thought, "where could we go together" and I decided to bring you to your favorite restaurant because you love these chocolate chip pancakes.

When you were really little you loved these pancakes and you'd get the chocolate all over your mouth and me and your mom would just laugh. So this is always a happy place, so I brought you here. So dig in!

**Daughter:** More, Daddy, more.

**Dad:** Sweetheart, just eat what you have and then if you want more we'll get you more.
