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- What** Emma struggles to be vulnerable with her Dad and express her painful secret. (Themes: Integrity, Sex, Honesty, Parents)
- Who** Emma
Mom
Dad
- When** Present day
- Wear (Props)** Have parents wear “parent attire” and Emma with a backpack and school clothes. Also, a newspaper, remote control, and kitchen tray with plate.

- Time** Approximately 3-5 minutes

Dad reads paper as Mom reads Harlequin romance novel. Living room setting. Dad is in recliner and Mom is on the couch.

Dad: Sweetie, could you get me some more coffee? It's getting cold. Honey...? Are you reading that Harlequin trash again? Always reading that romance trash about those fake lives that don't exist. Pure smut.

Mom: What?

Dad: Nothing. Just go back to reading your smut. That's fine.

Emma enters. She looks unsure, nervous.

Mom: Emma! I didn't see you.

Emma: Hi.

Mom: I have your dinner all ready. I just need to go heat it up...

Dad: Hey, while you're there could you heat up this coffee?

Emma: Mom, could I talk to you for a second?

Mom: Sure, honey. But let's get some food in you first. You look starved.

Emma: *(To Dad)* Hey, Dad. Could I talk to you for a second?

Dad: Yeah. Talk. *(Still looking at paper)*

Emma: Could you look at me and put the paper down? *(He does)* Um, Dad? I need to talk to you about sex.

Dad: You're kidding, right? You don't really want to talk about sex. Was there like, some series at church again? 'Cuz every time there's a series at church, you come home, "Oh, I want to talk about sex." It then turns into a talk about STD's and SUV's and TLC's, or whatever kind of transmitted disease you get. I don't want to talk about it, all right? You're in junior high for goodness...

Emma: I'm in high school! I am seventeen!

Dad: All right, whatever. We are not talking about sex in this house. Period. Okay?

Emma: You can watch the "Sex and the City" series but we can't talk about it?

Dad: I thought it was, "Caroline in the City." It was an innocent mistake!

- Mom:** (*Mom enters with food*) Emma, I left the gravy on the side because sometimes you like the gravy on your stuffing and sometimes you don't...
- Dad:** Oh, she wants more than gravy! You know what she wants now? Our Emma wants "the sex." That's what your daughter wants!
- Emma:** Dad!
- Mom:** What?
- Dad:** Yep! She wants "the sex!" Your daughter wants...
- Mom:** I went into the kitchen for stuffing and I came out for sex?
- Dad:** Oh, yeah. Your daughter wants "the sex."
- Emma:** I just have some questions!
- Mom:** You know what? Let's just stop this car right now! Back up... what have I missed?
- Dad:** Oh, your daughter put it into overdrive and now she can't jump out because she wants "the sex."
- Emma:** That's not true!
- Dad:** Uh, huh. Where did you get this idea in your head?
- Emma:** Well, my friend, Victoria, was talking and she always has these steamy stories...
- Dad:** Wait a minute. Didn't I tell you to stop listening to Victoria's secrets? She's no good...
- Mom:** Jack, calm down. She just wants to talk about it. (To **Emma**) You do just want to talk about it, right?
- Emma:** Yes... exactly... I just have some questions, Mom.
- Dad:** You just have some questions? We have an innocent nine-year-old son who's lying in bed asleep up there, and you want to talk about sex?
- Emma:** He's watching MTV in his room with the door closed!
- Dad:** That's fine as long as he keeps the volume down and he doesn't want to come down and talk about what he sees!
