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- What** Two friends have an exciting weekend at a football game and a rock concert, but when it comes to church on Sunday the excitement seems to fade away. Themes: Worship, Focus, Idols, Church, Hypocrisy
- Who** Actor 1
Actor 2
- When** Present; over the course of a weekend
- Wear (Props)** Two chairs
Football
Football jersey
Sunglasses
Hats
Bible
Optional - Musical backgrounds for football game, concert and worship service
- Why** Psalm 47:1, Psalm 149:3, Ephesians 5:19
- How** Feel free to change up the football team and the concert to make it relevant to where you live and to current pop culture. At the end, there is a serious turn during the “worship service”. Be careful not to overact. When you have a monologue that leads the actor to a different conclusion than what he/she originally believed or thought, give yourself plenty of time to process the thoughts. In this case, the thoughts are spoken, so don’t be in a hurry to get the lines out.
- Time** Approximately 5-7 minutes; This script is 4 pages long.

Actors come in wearing jerseys and carrying a football.

Actor 1: This is so amazing. I can't believe it. We are at a Dallas Cowboy football game. I am so excited about this!

Actor 2: I can't believe we scored these sweet tickets. This has got to be one of the best moments of my life. Ok, here it comes, my favorite part of the whole game. We are about to do the wave! Hurry, sit down!

Actors do the wave waiting for the wave to make it back around to them several times. If you have an energetic group, they most likely will do the wave with you.

Actor 1: This is so awesome! *(Lots of loud screaming)* Let's go Cowboys! Go Boys!

Actor 2: Yes! Yes! Go Cowboys!

Actor 1: They're gonna score! They're gonna score! He's to the 20...15...10...5....TOUCHDOWN!

Actor 2: Touchdown Cowboys! *(High five and hug)* This is so great! Yes, yes! Cowboys all the way, baby!

Actor 1: Hey, it's almost halftime. Let's get down there and see if we can't get a few autographs and then grab a hot dog! Woo - Go Cowboys!

Actor 2: Go Boys! This is so awesome and amazing!

The actors leave the stage area cheering and yelling for the Boys

Optional: The actors come into a song sung by Hannah Montana.

Actor 1: Yes, this is so amazing! I can't believe that you won these free Hannah Montana concert tickets. Wow! This is so exciting!

Actor 2: I know, right? This is like a dream come true! Are you kidding me?

Actor 1: I know I'm 30 years old but I don't care. She is amazing! *(Change age if need be).*

Actor 2: Yeah, I guess it is a little awkward for us to be here...who cares? I love you Hannah Montana! Nobody's perfect! You are great Hannah Montana!

Actor 1: Hannah! You are so great! Hannaaaahhhh!!!

Both actors dance around to the song yelling how much they love Hannah. The crazier the dancing, the better.

- Actor 1:** Hannah! Hannah! I love you... *(begins to cry)*...Hannah...I love you so much...
- Actor 2:** Ok, ok, just settle down there. Take it easy. Hey, hey, I forgot to tell you. When I won these tickets, I forgot to tell you that we also got *(pulls out tickets)* BACKSTAGE PASSES!
- Actor 1:** Are you kidding me? Are you kidding me? This is so amazing! Oh my goodness!
- Actor 2:** Hurry, let's get out of here and line up for our backstage passes. Come on!
- Actor 1:** *(Being pulled off the stage by actor 2)* I love you Hannah. I am coming to see you! I am coming to see you!

The actors leave the stage cheering for Hannah Montana.

Optional: Actors enter back onto stage with a praise song playing. Grab a CD with a live worship service to play. As the actors enter, it's as if they are going to their Sunday morning worship service.

ENDING:

- Actor 2:** Show me. Do it.
- Actor 1:** *(Puts head down and begins to sleep; Actor 1 is asleep from this point on.)*
- Actor 2:** That is so awesome. So, wait a second. Everyone thinks that you're reading your Bible but really you're just sleeping. That is so awesome. You are so great at this church stuff. I have got to come to church with you more often. You are the queen (or king) of church trickery. Wow, what a crazy weekend. It was so fun! We seriously must have stood and cheered for 10 hours straight. What a great weekend!

Allow actor to be silent for 5-10 seconds as he is doing some thinking.

Hey, I was thinking about something earlier. Do you feel bad? The thing is that I feel kinda bad right now. I mean, we went to the football game where we stood up and cheered for 5 hours straight. Then, we went to the concert where we cheered and danced for hours. Well, I was thinking, shouldn't we feel bad because we have all that passion and

excitement for those things, but when it comes to church we don't have any excitement or passion at all? I just feel bad, ya know? *(Talking to Actor 1)* Hello? Are you listening? *(Actor 2 pushes Actor 1 to see if they are awake; no response from Actor 1)*

Great, he (she) is already asleep. Well, you know what? If worship is going to change, if worship is going to change in this place, it starts with me. *(Stands up from chair)* It starts with me *(raises hand in air and freezes)*.

I love you Lord. *(Freezes)*

Lights out. The end.
