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- What** In this skit, a Guy and a Girl know the words to 1 Corinthians 13, but totally miss the meaning. This is a fun skit to kick off a discussion about love and dating. Themes: Love, Dating, Relationships, True Love, Hypocrisy
- Who** Guy
Girl
- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** No props
- Why** 1 Corinthians 13
- How** This is a fun skit to do to pit the guys against the girls. You can have a great discussion about true love or dating after a skit like this. The goal is to get the kids screaming for their side. At the end of the skit, the mood turns serious, making for a great conversation on love, dating, and relationships.
- Both actors need to have a quick wit and be spontaneous with crowd reactions and feedback. And if done correctly, there will be crowd feedback.
- Time** Approximately 3-5 minutes; This script is 3 pages long.

Guy: Hello everyone. Got a question for you. Where the guys at in the house? Make some noise!!

Guys in crowd respond

Girl: That is weak. Where are my ladies at? Let me hear you.

Guy: C'mon guys. Let's do better than that. Let me hear you.

Girls: Ladies, let's do this. Make some noise! 1...2...3!

Guy: Alright, alright, the ladies are a little louder. You got me. Well, tonight, we are talking about love. Yes, it's true. So since the ladies were a lot louder and *(name of actress here)* here is an expert about love, I am going to allow her the opportunity to tell you fine folks about love. So, take it away. Tell everyone here about love.

Girl: Ok. Will do. Thank you. Ok, how do I describe love? Love is...
(pause)...love is...oh this is so hard to put into words. Love is...

Guy is looking at watch and tapping his foot impatiently at this point, maybe even a few sighs.

Guy: Ok, listen. I know that you want to explain love but we really need to hurry, ok? We have a lot to do here so let's tell everyone about love so we can move on...alright?

Girl: Ok, ok. Just go back over there. Let me do this. Guys are always in such a hurry. Ok, love...love is...love is like a field of daisies, all nice and sweet and they smell real pretty...and you are running through the flowers...

Guy: *(Interrupting the girl)* Ok, love is patient... blah, blah, blah...moving on now.

Girl: Hey! That was my line.

Guy: *(Very smug)* Love is kind.

Girl: And why do you get all the good lines anyway?

Guy: *(Very stern)* Love does not envy. And besides, everyone here knows I'm the better actor.

Girl: *(Very surprised and offended)* Excuse me? Love sure doesn't boast!

Guy: Well it sure isn't proud. Proud Mary keep on rolling'. *(Snap of the fingers in a Z formation)*

- Girl:** *(Getting more upset)* It isn't rude!
- Guy:** *(Staying calm, but rude)* It is not self-seeking.
- Girl:** *(Yelling and very angry)* WELL IT SURE ISN'T EASILY ANGERED! *(Speaking to the audience)* Oh, I'm sorry...I guess I got a bit angry there.
- Guy:** *(Blown away by her actions)* You sure did! I accept your apology.
- Girl:** You what?? I did not apologize to you, "Mr. I'm the better actor". I was speaking to them. Besides you are the one that should say that you are sorry to me! First you steal my lines...
- Guy:** *(Interrupting)* There you go again. Just like a woman! You always bring up the past. Do you know what the Bible says about that? It says love keeps no record of wrong.
