- What** Two clueless characters decide it would be fun to blindly walk through life, and cause great pain to a dog owner (Themes: Blindness, Purpose, Consequences, Pain, Foolishness)
- Who** Actor 1
Actor 2
Dog Owner
- When** Present day
- Wear (Props)** 2 pair of pantyhose
2 chairs
toy gun (optional)
- Why** John 3:19-21, Matthew 15:14
- How** Have fun with this skit. The two actors are fools and should be played as such. This is a fairly physical skit and will require a bit more rehearsal to make the physical humor tight.
- Time** Approximately 4-6 minutes

The skit starts with Actor 1 and 2 meeting. These characters are very, very clueless.

Actor 2: Hey, buddy!

Actor 1: Hey man, what's up?

Actor 2: Not much, what do you want to do?

Actor 1: I don't know what do you want to do?

Actor 2: Hey, you want to go put some of your sister's pantyhose on our heads?

Actor 1: Yeah! (*Puts pantyhose over head*) Hey I can't really see anything.

Actor 2: Yeah me either!

Actor 1 should be facing Actor 2, but Actor 2 should be facing the opposite direction.

Actor 1: Hey you know what would be fun?

Actor 2: Going bungee jumping while eating creamed corn?

Actor 1: Well yeah, but something better! Let's go drive the car around!

Actor 2: But we can't see anything! What if we hit something?

Actor 1: No worries, I'm getting my learner's permit in like two years so it's all good.

Actor 2: Well as long as it's legal. Hey do you know where the car is?

Actor 1: Yeah it's over here.

Actor 2: Oh, okay.

Both walk in opposite directions, but end up back in the middle running into each other and the car.

Actor 2: So hey, do you have the keys to your mom's car?

Actor 1: Yeah she always keeps them in the ignition for safety purposes... well, you know.

Actor 1 starts car, Actor 2 goes along for the ride.

Actor 2: Hey, let's turn on the radio. Yeah, I love this song! (*Singing badly*) "What is love? Baby, don't hurt me. Don't hurt me. No more!"

Actor 1: (*As if ear is about to fall off*) Ah, don't hurt me!

Actor 2: Sorry.
