- When** Black Friday- Day after Thanksgiving
- Wear (Props)** Ladies should be dressed as close to football players as possible- i.e. jerseys, black grease under their eyes, wristbands, etc.)
Whistle for Louise
Huge purses
Coats for all ladies
Joe is dressed in camouflage
White board and marker
- Why** For fun and to remind us how we can get carried away sometimes.
- How** This is a fun sketch, so make sure you use actors that will be fearless on stage and not afraid to be silly. Have fun with this and really make it yours.
- Time** Approximately 3-5 minutes

*The ladies are standing around stretching and getting amped up for the "big game."
Louise blows her whistle bringing them together.*

Louise: Okay ladies, now huddle up. *(Looking at her watch)* It's 4:05 AM, it's black Friday, and it's the moment we've been training for.

Ladies: Yeah! *(Exchange high fives)*

Dorothy: *(Getting overly amped up)* This is it, ladies, it's game time!

Louise: Save it for the game, Dorothy. You don't want to peak too soon

Dorothy: Right coach. Sorry.

Michelle: Coach, where's Barb?

Susie: Yeah, she's our starting tackle.

Louise: Barb's out this year. She and Harold went to visit the kids this Thanksgiving.

They all exchange groans.

Louise: But listen, I've brought in a backup *(whistling off-stage)*. Joe! Honey, it's time to get out of the car.

Dorothy: You brought your husband?

Michelle: *(Impressed)* How'd you manage that?

Louise: It was easy. I told him they spotted a twelve point buck at the mall. I didn't tell him it was a plastic reindeer.

All the ladies give her a high five. Joe comes in all decked out in camo.

Joe: Are you sure there's a buck at the mall? All I see are women.

Louise: Yes, sweetie. I promise today there will be LOTS of bucks at the mall. Now why don't you take our purses and set up outside of Macy's like we talked about?

They all drape their purses on him and he shuffles off with a groan.

Louise: *(Pulling out a small whiteboard and drawing the game plan)* Okay, now here's the plan. Michelle, I need you to run a post route across the food court and head straight to Starbucks®. Everything hinges on caffeine today.

Susie: *(Protesting)* But I thought I was making the Starbucks® run?

Louise: Not after last year's fumble. You almost cost us the game! I'm giving it to Michelle this year.
