- Who** The Rock Star

- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** The Rock Star- should wear “hip” clothes
The Secular Re-conditioners- should also wear hip clothes
The Purist- should wear a shirt that’s buttoned all the way up and tie; He has a hymnal
The Looney- has a box for a “snake”
- Why** Philippians 2:1-11; Psalm 46:10; Psalm 95:6
- How** Each character is different, so if you are playing all of the characters be sure to really distinguish them from each other. - Time** Approximately 4-6 minutes; This script is 2¼ pages long
