Husband: Good, and I'll get helmets, shoulder pads, duct tape and maybe pepper spray.

Wife: You are not buying those things.

Husband: Oh honey, trust me. Thanksgiving with my family? We'll need it.

Wife: No we won't.

Husband: Oh yes we will. Your family had the whole say grace before meals thing going on, mine was, "Prepare for war!!!"

Wife: Sweetie, the Manson family doesn't need those things for Thanksgiving dinner.

Husband: What else do you have in mind then?

Wife: Do you want to pray about it?
