- Audience:** High School
- Time:** Approximately 3-5 minutes

Actor 2: Did what hurt?

Actor 1: When you fell from heaven did it hurt?

Actor 2: Oh that’s gold.

Actor 1: Alright or try this: Are you tired?

Actor 2: No why?

Actor 1: Because you’ve been running through my mind all day!

Actor 2: Oh that’s good too!

Actor 1: Ok, go talk to her.

Actor 2: *(to number 3, nervously)* Hey Jessica...I was wondering are you tired...or hurting...my mind...in heaven?
