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- What** This skit shows a teenage boy who has to face consequences to his future after having sex with girlfriend. (Themes: Responsibility, Parenting, Consequences, Sex, Love)
- Who** Steve Kane
- When** Present day
- Wear (Props)** None
- Why** Please see *The Power of Sex* series outlines for several scripture references; message title “*I’ve Messed Up In This Area, Now What?*” Download messages at [www.simplyyouthministry.com](http://www.simplyyouthministry.com).
- How** The more sincerely the actor plays this monologue, the better this will play in front of an audience. He also needs to be a very confident actor and comfortable in front of others.
- Time** Approximately 4-6 minutes

*Steve Kane enters the stage. It should look as if a student is presenting a testimony of what is going on in his life.*

**Steve:** *(Clearly he has some heavy things on his heart)* Hey. My name is Steve Kane. I'm sixteen years old. I've been going out with this girl...who will remain nameless...for quite awhile. Major commitment. Very serious. How long? About five months. You may say that isn't a long time, but for us it seems like an eternity. It's the longest I've ever been with a girl.

You see, I love her. *(Doubting)* I think I love...no, no I do. This is love. It has to be right. I've never had feelings like this for someone. See, the reason I know I love her is, well, *(Pause)* we, we have... you know... *(Beat)*...a lot.

We have been having... um... "relations", oh you know what I mean, for a while now. *(Beat)* About two months and four days, but who's counting.

This is going to sound kind of weird, especially coming from a guy, but I'm kind of getting tired of it. Crazy right? I mean we're always sneaking around, lying to our parents, and to be honest I've never been with anyone before, and I'm not sure if I'm even doing things right.

I live in constant fear of her parents finding out. They would freak out if they knew what we were up to when we go out on dates. They don't like me anyway. Her dad is a big wheel at her church. I'm not that religious or anything. It makes for very uncomfortable silent conversations when I pick her up.

On the other hand my Dad, if we talked, would just kind of give me a wink and a nudge and welcome me into The Clan of Manhood, or something.

My mom used to go to church. She would take me and my sister with her. She doesn't go anymore. I think it's 'cause Dad always gave her a hard time about being weak minded and taking religion too seriously, or something.
