- What** There are many ways to count your blessings this Thanksgiving, even in song. In this video, The script illustrates the importance of doing a quick inventory of all you have to be thankful for this year. Themes: Thanksgiving, Gratitude, Blessings, Thankful
- Who** Actor 1
Actor 2
- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** Actor 2 should have a guitar
Dress is casual
- Why** Colossians 3:15; 1 Thessalonians 5:18
- How** This is a fun skit to do that can be either two men, two women, or one man and one woman. Both actors should have a good sense of comic timing, and it would be good if Actor 2 could play the guitar and sing. If you have a screen and can use slides, work with your media minister to have graphics on your screen. - Time** Approximately 2-4 minutes

Actor 1 addresses the audience. Actor 2 enters and stands next to him. While Actor 1 addresses the audience, Actor 2's dialogue is to Actor 1 unless otherwise noted.

Actor 1: Have you ever stopped to take inventory of your blessings...you know, the things you should be thankful for?

Actor 2: Oh yeah, like Eskimo Pies®. I'm so thankful for them! I mean, they're ice cream and cookie put together...and...*(to the audience)* thank you Eskimo Pie® people!

Actor 1: That's not what I'm really getting at.

Actor 2: Oh. You mean serious stuff, like zippers. I mean, where would we be without zippers? They let us in and out of our clothes. Up and down! Thank you.

Actor 1: What I want the people to do out there is to pause from their busy schedules and just add up all their blessings no matter what their circumstances.

Actor 2: Oh! Circumstances! Like the other day my zipper was stuck, I couldn't get out, and I was freaking out. And then I thought, "What if I was a space man? What do space men do when their zipper gets stuck?" And then I was thankful I wasn't a space man.

Actor 1: Take the inventory and I think you will realize how much God has given you. And that will make you so thankful.

Actor 1: He's going to go take the inventory.
